MEETING VIA TELECONFERENCE TO CONSIDER UPDATING THE SFPUC'S PERMANENT MANDATORY WATER WASTE RESTRICTIONS

During its regular meeting on February 22, 2022, at 1:30 PM, to be held via teleconference, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) will hold a public hearing to consider updating the SFPUC's permanent water waste restrictions (Resolution 16-0127), also contained in Section E, Rule 12 of the SFPUC's Rules and Regulations Governing Water Service to Customers and Resolution, to add a new provision prohibiting any homeowner's association or community service organization from penalizing or threatening individual owners who take measures to reduce irrigation use, to reflect a similar provision in the counterpart emergency water waste regulations adopted by the California State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) on January 4, 2022 (Resolution 2022-0002) in response to California's current drought.
