East SOMA Sewer Improvements Project

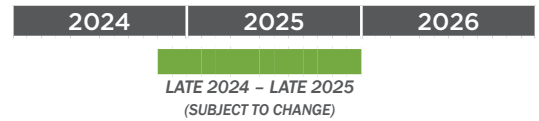
Our Sewer System Upgrades are Underway

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) operates a combined sewer system that collects and treats San Francisco’s wastewater (sewage and stormwater). Our Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) is upgrading and modernizing our system to ensure we can continue to protect public health and the environment now and into the future.

As part of the SSIP investments, the East SOMA Sewer Improvements Project will rehabilitate the existing 100-year-old sewer mains and sewer lower laterals located under the streets highlighted on the Project Map.

Wherever possible and to minimize impacts to the roadway and adjacent residences and businesses, most of the sewer improvements work will be performed using a trenchless method called Cured-in-Place Pipe (CIPP) sfpuc.org/curedpipe. Where CIPP cannot be performed, the sewer mains will be replaced or rehabilitated with open excavation. When completed, this project will increase the reliability of our City’s critical sewer system infrastructure.

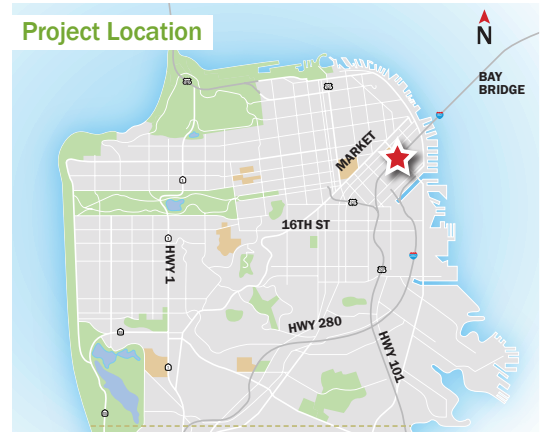
Estimated Construction Schedule



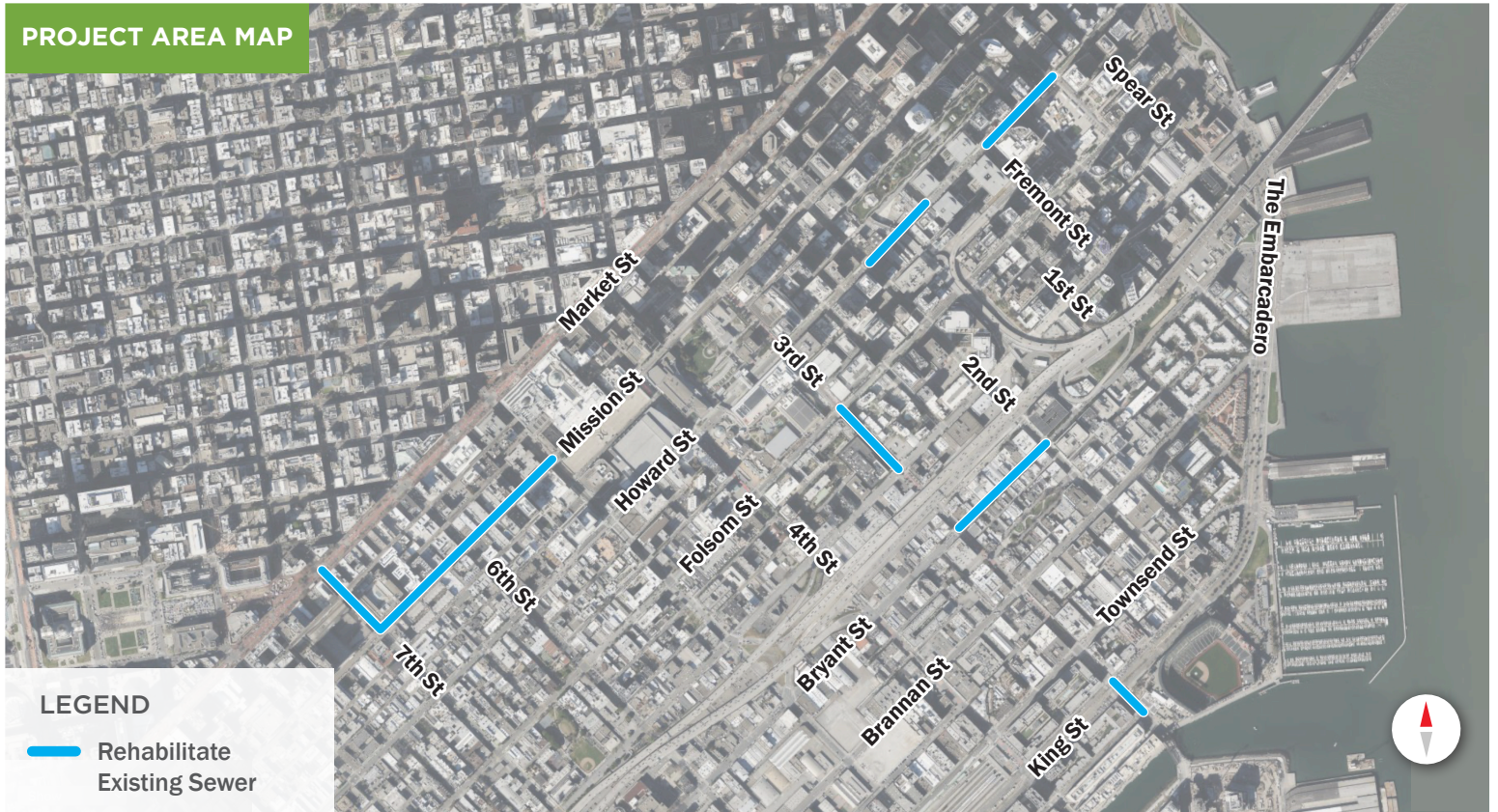

What to expect:

- **SEWER SERVICES** These services will NOT be interrupted during construction.
- **PARKING:** Street parking will be impacted near construction zones. “No-parking” signs will be posted 72 hours in advance.
- **TRAFFIC:** Partial lane closures may be necessary to ensure safety of workers and the public. Advance notice and detour signage will be provided, as needed.
- **MUNI:** Passenger loading zone for bus stops may be temporary relocated. Advance notice and detour signage will be provided as needed.
- **ACCESS:** Follow posted signage on site. Driveway access to businesses and residents in the work zone will be maintained during construction.
- **NOISE:** Neighbors may hear construction noise periodically. Noisy work will be conducted in compliance with the San Francisco Noise Ordinance.
- **ODORS:** If necessary, odor control measures will be in place during construction. Please see CIPP page for more information. sfpuc.org/curedpipe
- **NOTICE:** A 30-day and 10-day notice will be distributed prior to construction to residents and businesses within the project area before construction begins.

The East SOMA Sewer Improvements Project is part of the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP), a multibillion-dollar citywide investment in our aging sewer system. The program is the result of an extensive community planning and will ensure a reliable, sustainable, and seismically safe sewer system now and for generations to come.
