# GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE GRANTS FOR HOMES

### RESIDENTIAL LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR OPPORTUNITY

### What is the Green Infrastructure Grants for Homes Program?

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission's (SFPUC) has launched a pilot program to provide grant funding for green infrastructure on residential properties. The goals of the pilot program are to reduce the amount of stormwater runoff entering the sewer system and to lower the stormwater portion of customers' sewer service charge.

## Are you a residential landscape contractor or plumber?

As part of this pilot program, SFPUC is developing a list of contractors who are interested in partnering with participating homeowners to design and build residential landscape projects. Potential contracting work will include design and build for **new landscaping**, roof drainage and plumbing work, concrete/paving work, laying aggregate base and pavers, installing rainwater cisterns, and general contractor services.

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### What will the grant program fund?

The Pilot Program will provide grant funding to homeowners to cover the full costs of design and construction of the following project types: rain garden, rainwater harvesting cistern, permeable pavement or an infiltration trench.
