# Chinatown and North Beach Brick Sewer Rehabilitation Project

## Our Sewer System Upgrades are Underway

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC) operates a combined sewer system that collects and treats San Francisco's wastewater (sewage and stormwater). Our Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP) is upgrading and modernizing our system to ensure we can continue to protect public health and the environment now and into the future.

As part of the SSIP investments, the Chinatown and North Beach Brick Sewer Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate the existing 100-year-old sewer mains located under the streets highlighted on the Project Map in the following page.

To minimize impacts to the roadway and adjacent residences and businesses, most of the sewer rehabilitation work will be performed using a trenchless method called Cured-in-Placed Pipe (CIPP) **sfpuc.org/curedpipe**. Construction will include improvements to sewer lower laterals within the project area. In some locations, street excavation will be required, and advance notice will be provided. This project aims to increase the reliability of our City's critical sewer system infrastructure.

## What to Expect

- SEWER SERVICE These services will NOT be interrupted during construction.
- **PARKING:** Street parking will be impacted near construction zones. "No-parking" signs will be posted 72 hours in advance.
- TRAFFIC: Partial and/or full lane closures may be necessary to ensure safety of workers and the public. Advance notice and detour signage will be provided, as needed.
- MUNI: Bus stops may be impacted during SFMTA's transit work. For transit and bus stop work, please call (415) 701-2311 for temporary bus stops information.
- ACCESS: Follow posted signage on site. Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their driveways and entrances during construction.
- NOISE: Neighbors may hear construction noise periodically. Noisy work will be conducted in compliance with the San Francisco Noise Ordinance.
- ODORS: If necessary, odor control measures will be in place during construction. Please see CIPP page for more information sfpuc.org/curedpipe.
- **NOTICE:** Residents and businesses within the project area will be notified before construction begins.

The Chinatown and North Beach Brick Sewer Rehabilitation Project is part of the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP), a 20-year, multibilliondollar citywide investment required to upgrade our aging sewer system. The program is the result of an extensive community planning process and will ensure a reliable, sustainable and seismically safe sewer system now and for generations to come.
