

Traffic Advisory & Construction Notice Westside Pump Station Reliability Project Update

Description: Upgrades continue at the Westside Pump Station, our all-weather facility that pumps the sanitary and stormwater flow from the west side of the City to the Oceanside Treatment Plant for treatment. As part of the improvements and modifications to ensure the Westside Pump Station is reliable and operationally flexible, we will be bringing redundant electrical power to the site from an existing source near Sloat Blvd. and 47th Avenue. The work will require trenching from 47th Avenue, across Sloat and down the southside of Sloat to the pump station. In addition, sidewalk accessibility upgrades will be completed at the intersection of 43rd & Sloat and 41st & Sloat.

When: The anticipated start date for electrical conduit installation is **November 1st**, with an expected <u>duration of 5 weeks</u>. Weather and/or construction issues may impact the schedule. Workdays and hours (weather permitting) are Monday – Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Where: Construction activities will occur near the intersection of 47th Avenue and Sloat, cross Sloat and continue south to the pump station. Sidewalk improvements are also planned at 41st & Sloat and 43rd & Sloat.

What to expect:


- TRAFFIC: For public and worker safety, lane restrictions will be required. Signage will be present to direct traffic. We anticipate one-lane of traffic will remain open in all directions.
- ACCESS: Businesses and residents in the work zone will maintain access to their properties (including entries, driveways, garages), although there may be temporary delays
- PARKING: Parking will be restricted in the work zone. Please see posted signs for exact details
- NOISE/VIBRATION: While the contractor is required to abide by the City's noise and vibration ordinances, neighbors should expect some noise and limited dust during this work. The project team will work to minimize disruption to normal neighborhood activity; however, there will be occasional inconveniences due to heavy equipment movement and other construction activities
- SERVICE: No interruption in sewer service is expected during construction

Estimated Completion: The project continues to make headway and the current estimate for completion is early 2025. Learn more at SFPUC.org/westsidepump
